

## FAQs

All GP practices have come together to form a provider organisation called Nimbuscare to deliver things that make sense to be delivered at scale. Nimbuscare is providing the vaccination service for all practices - one reason for this is to ensure that GPs can continue business as usual.

**Q. *Where are the vaccination sites?***

**A.** Askham Bar (old Park and Ride site)

**A.** Haxby Group – WONE (West Outer and North East York) PCB (Front Street, Haxby, Old School Medical Practices)

**Q. *Are there any plans to open any more sites in York?***

**A.** Satellite site - Pocklington Practice

Initially Local Vaccination Service on behalf of the CCG

National Mass Vaccination Centre - co-located at Askham Bar

**Q. *How do people book a vaccination?***

**A.** PCNs will invite patients to book against the priority cohorts put in place by the JCVI  
Care home residents and patients will be vaccinated by practices  
Housebound patients - service to commence on 23rd Jan

National Vacc Centre - patients will be contacted by the NHS and will be asked to use the national booking website

**Q. *Can people book to have their vaccination at their local GP surgery?***

**A.** Not in every practice - Haxby and Pocklington only at this stage

**Q. *What arrangements are being put in place to vaccinate the housebound or elderly/disabled people who can't get to a mass vaccination centre?***

**A.** PCNs are working with Nimbuscare - starting 23rd January (delay due to AZ vaccine coming on line and supply issues)

Here is the eligibility for vaccination (the JCVI prioritisation) list.

1. residents in a care home for older adults and their carers
2. all those 80 years of age and over and frontline health and social care workers
3. all those 75 years of age and over
4. all those 70 years of age and over and clinically extremely vulnerable individuals
5. all those 65 years of age and over
6. all individuals aged 16 years to 64 years with underlying health conditions which put them at higher risk of serious disease and mortality
7. all those 60 years of age and over

8. all those 55 years of age and over
9. all those 50 years of age and over

***Q. Are there enough staff to deliver the vaccination programme?***

Yes - Practice support, Other stakeholders, Bank Staff, Dentists, Returners

***Q. Any problems with supply of vaccine?***

Yes - national issue - seems to be improving but slowly - Comms embargo

**Some performance data e.g. number of vaccinations done so far**

c8000 done at Askham Bar (1500 care home residents and staff)

c4000 done at Haxby

c 4000 PCN Service

7-8000 per week at National Vacc Centre

c7000 per week at York Hospital
